



School Closure Notification

March 18, 2020

Dear Texas Preparatory School Parents:

This communication is to inform you that due to the continued COVID-19 (Coronavirus) we will be closing our campuses, starting Monday, March 23rd – Friday, April 3rd as it is necessary for the safety of our students and staff. We tentatively plan to return Monday, April 6th, but parents should proactively make arrangements if we are required to remain closed. We will continue to monitor and take direction from local, state and federal officials and communicate them as they unfold.

While we are not able to meet in person, our goal is to continue providing our students with instruction and support while at home. We will not hold remote classes March 23rd -27th, in order for our teaching staff to train, plan and communicate. The projected start date for remote learning is Monday, March 30th.

I understand that you likely have many questions during this time. While we do not have all the answers today, our team has been working to provide more clarity as this situation unfolds to include the details for remote learning technology needs, child nutrition and continued local COVID-19 (Coronavirus) updates.

The plan is to resume classes on Monday, April 6, 2020. In the event a decision is made to remain closed, you will receive communication via the schools email list, Class Dojo, website and social media. Please make sure that you stay tuned for any updates and decisions.
