I am writing to inform you that due to the continued COVID-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic, we will be extending our school closure at both the Austin and San Marcos campuses through Monday, April 13, 2020 in response to the Stay Home – Work Safe Orders issued by local authorities. This means our return date has been re-scheduled for Tuesday, April 14, 2020 pending any further decisions or directions from local, state and federal officials. We want to continue to encourage parents to proactively make arrangements for continued closure in case authorities require us to remain closed.

We will be providing our students with instructional continuity and support, food service and technology while at home. Please be advised of the start dates for each service:

- Child Nutrition and Food Distribution has started, Thursday, March 26th.
- Technology Access and Distribution to start, Friday, March 27th.
- Remote Instructional Continuity and Support to start, Monday, March 30th.

We will continue to provide these services for our students as long as our campuses are closed.

In the event a decision is made to remain closed, you will receive communication via the schools' email list, Class Dojo, website and social media. Please make sure that you stay connected for updates and decisions.
